- A name badge will be provided to each camper and must be worn at all times unless indicated by Camp staff.

- If a camper is signed up for Adventure camp for the week and would like to join PB Explorers camp half day, they may do so for an additional \$150.
- Campers are required to bring a labeled waterbottle, towel, bathing suit, and sunscreen. Staff will not be permitted to apply sunscreen. Please ensure children come to Camp with their first application of sunscreen on.
- We have internally trained staff, so we can enjoy the Moreland pool each day! If your child is not able to swim, please send any flotation devices they may use with them or a note stating they are not allowed to use the pool. We will conduct a swim test on each camper's first day.
- There will be days that we get messy as Camp includes tie-dying, face paint, outdoor play, etc. Please dress your child appropriately for these activities.
- A weekly newsletter will be distributed to parents every Friday with information on the coming week. A copy of this newsletter is available to daily campers upon request.
- Reservations are required for Camp. Bookings can be made through the concierge or PB Explorers team and an Enrollment Form is required for each camper.
- Members may bring up to two guests to any camp. Unaccompanied guests will not be allowed to participate.
- Weekly camp reservation Enrollment Forms are due the Thursday prior by 5 pm or a daily rate will apply for the entire week. For daily reservations, an Enrollment Form is due 24 hours prior or a daily drop-in rate applies.

Camp is not responsible for the loss of clothing, equipment, or other personal belongings. Camp reserves the right to use photographs/videos of campers for promotional purposes, and the parent/guardian authorizes such use without compensation. With this application, permission is granted for the enrolled camper to participate in all activities.

Medical Permission Statement
